

121 Kinnelon Road, Kinnelon, New Jersey 07405

From Route 287 - Either North or South -- Rt. 287 to Exit 52B (Route 23 North); go approximately 3 miles on 23 North to jughandle for Kinnelon Road/Kiel Avenue (right lane exit). At end of jughandle, at light, make left. Cross Route 23. (You are now on Kinnelon Road.) Continue straight for approximately 1.5 miles. Kinnelon High School is on your left. Park in visitor parking in circle.

From Route 23 South: Take Kinnelon Road Exit (a right), (You are now on Kinnelon Road.) Continue straight for approximately 1.5 miles. Kinnelon High School is on your left. Park in visitor parking in circle

From Rockaway/Denville Area: Take Diamond Spring Road about 4.5 miles to your 1st Stop Sign. Make a left onto Powerville Road (turns into Kinnelon Road when you enter Kinnelon). Take Powerville 4.8 miles to the high school on your right.
