

Registration

The event is open to individuals and teams. If participating as a team you must designate one person to be your team captain. This person will be responsible for registering the team's participants, obtaining waiver signatures and submitting appropriate fees for entry. The captain will also make arrangements for the pick-up or delivery of the team race numbers and t-shirts.

Individuals can pick up their race packets at UCP before race day or on race day at the event.

Make checks payable to: **UCP of Philadelphia & Vicinity**. Payment must accompany registration form. Your check in excess of \$10 per participant is tax deductible. If mailed, registrations must be postmarked by April 6, 2007. Online registration available at www.active.com.

Each participant must read the liability waiver and sign the form in order to participate. Signatures can be sent on separate forms, but UCP **MUST** have a signature for each participant.

Race packets include t-shirt and race number. They can be shipped to team captains or they may be picked up at UCP April 9-13, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. (Please see registration form for shipping information.)

Late registrants can pick up their race number at the registration table on race day. Teams that register late will be charged a \$20 late fee.

Entry Fee

An entry fee of \$25 dollars will be charged PER PERSON, not per team. There is no limit to the number of participants on a team, however, there is a minimum of three participants to a team.

Race Notes

The UCP 5K Corporate Run/Walk will be held rain or shine. Water, medical support, safety pins, and post-race refreshments will be available on-site. The first 1,200 registered participants will receive a t-shirt. Complete race results will be posted at the race and on our website www.ucpphila.org.

Awards will be distributed to the top individuals and the top teams. Team scores are based on the times of the top three runners on each team.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: APRIL 6, 2007

No one is allowed to participate without signing the waiver. Please read carefully, then sign on back of registration form under "Team Member Release Signature." I know that participating in the UCP 5K Corporate Run/Walk is a potentially hazardous activity. I should not enter and run unless I am medically able and properly trained. I agree to abide by any decision of a race official, relative to my ability to safely run. I assume all risks associated with running in the UCP 5K Corporate Run/Walk, including, but not limited to: falls, contact with other participants, the effects of weather, including high heat and/ or humidity, traffic and the conditions of the road, all such risks being known and appreciated by me. Having read this waiver and knowing these facts and in consideration of your acceptance of my application and granting permission for my participation in the event, and intending to be legally bound hereby, I hereby for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, waive and release United Cerebral Palsy of Philadelphia & Vicinity, and any other sponsors, coordinating groups, and individuals associated with this event, their representatives, successors, and assigns from any and all claims or liabilities of any kind arising out of my participation in this event even though that liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons named in this waiver, and agree that I will hold them harmless from any injuries or damages which I may suffer in this event. None of the persons named in this waiver shall be responsible for the loss of personal items nor other form of aggravation in connection with the event. I hereby grant permission for all of the foregoing to use my name and picture in any photographs, motion picture, broadcast, telecast, Internet or print media account of this event for any legitimate purpose. *Remember to register by April 6, 2007 to receive t-shirts early and avoid the late fee of \$20.
