

Take Alps Road at the 3rd set of lights on Alps Road make a right and a quick left (if you go right only, you will be on Ratzer Road). Continue on Alps Road to the next light and make a left onto Hamburg Turnpike. Go to 2nd light and make a right onto Cyanamid Drive. Terhune Elementary School is on the right.

FROM ROUTE 23 SOUTH: Take Route 23S to the Jackson Avenue jug-handle. Cross Route 23 and continue on Jackson Ave. At first light, make a right onto Black Oak Ridge Road. At next light, make a left onto Jackson Ave., a continuation of the first Jackson Ave. Make a left onto Squad Place, across from Fire Station. Follow Squad Place to end and make a left onto Hamburg Turnpike. Take Hamburg Turnpike to the 1st light and make a right onto Cyanamid Drive. Terhune Elementary School is on the right.

FROM ROUTE 80 WEST: Take Route 80 West to Route 23N. Follow directions from Route 23N. FROM ROUTE 80 EAST: Take Route 80 East to Route 46 East. Take Route 46 East to Route 23N. Follow Route 23N directions.

FROM ROUTE 287 NORTH: Take Route 287N to Route 23S. Follow directions from Route 23S. FROM NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE NORTH: Take the New Jersey Turnpike North to Exit 16W, Route 3W. Take Route 3W. This will merge into Route 46W. Take Route 46W to Route 23N. Follow directions from Route 23N.

FROM ROUTE 4 WEST: Take Route 4W to Route 208 North. Take Route 208N. to the Colonial Road exit. From the exit ramp, make a left onto Colonial Road. Follow Colonial Road to the end and make a right onto Franklin Lakes Road. Go to the 2nd traffic light and make a left onto Breakneck Road, which will become Berdan Avenue. Take Berdan Avenue to the end and make a right onto Hamburg Turnpike. Take Hamburg Turnpike to the 3rd Traffic light and make a right onto Cyanamid Drive. Terhune Elementary School is on the right.
